Comprehensive School Improvement Plan

The Comprehensive School Improvement Plan, also known as the CSIP, is a 5 year plan the district uses to set goals for improving the school district. At the September board meeting, the board approved the updated plan. Goals in the plan include a focus on teacher retention and recruitment, post-high school preparedness, literacy, and social-emotional well-being of students. Action steps are in place to provide a framework of the work needed to meet the goals.

Therefore, gifts which may serve to enhance and extend the work of the schools may be received by the District as approved by the Board.

Individuals may choose to donate a specific item that is needed for a classroom, department, or organization. Others may choose to make a cash donation for a designated purpose.

This allows the district to work with the individual or organization to ensure that the product or donation is needed and appropriate, as well as ensuring any stipulations related to the donation are reasonable and manageable.

Bleacher Project

During the summer of 2023, we were able to complete the renovation of the bleachers in the gymnasium. With the updated seating we are able to seat over 750 people in the bleacher area. This updated look will provide some added comfort as we enjoy many of our student activities.

One exciting addition is the first 3 rows of bleachers which have backs on them. While we know these will be highly sought after seats, please be aware that some of our community members have difficulty traveling up stairs and will need access to this lower seating. We also plan to put chairs in the handicap accessible areas, but these will be removed, and individuals asked to relocate, if needed by someone in a wheelchair. With a caring community, such as ours, we know individuals will work together to make all events held in the gymnasium a comfortable experience for everyone involved.
