Parking Lot Update

Thank you for your patience as we have begun the work on the front parking lot. Overall the pick-up and drop-off procedures have worked fairly well. We've made a few minor adjustments in order to make the process as efficient as possible.

Thus far, the sidewalk has been completed, which included widening the walkway. We were able to partner with MODOT to replace the tubing along the road to improve the drainage. Currently they are working to move dirt to the appropriate grade to pour the 8 inches of concrete needed for the bus lane. The expected completion date for the entire project is November 10, 2023.

Fresh Fruit/Vegetable Grant

Green City R-1 has been awarded a fresh fruit and vegetable grant from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Food and Nutrition Services. The grant will allow the school district to serve, at no cost to students, a snack of fresh fruits and/or vegetables to our elementary students a few days per week. We are excited to provide this opportunity for our students to have access to fresh fruits and vegetables, with the goal of developing lifelong healthy eating habits.
