## Elementary Principal's Report

Jamie Halley presented the Elementary attendance rate of 96.36% for September and an overall attendance rate of 97.21% with enrollment of 152 students. Office referrals were discussed. Math Review, Math Facts, STAR Reading, and STAR Math data were discussed. The end of First Quarter is October 15<sup>th</sup>. MAP recognition night will be October 25<sup>th</sup>. Red Ribbon Week is in October. First Quarter Awards are October 27<sup>th</sup>. Halloween Parties were discussed and will be held October 29<sup>th</sup>. The School of Economics trip went well. An incentive trip is planned for October 21<sup>st</sup> in Centerville.

### High School Principal's Report

Jamie Tipton presented the High School attendance rate of 93% for October with enrollment of 121 students. Behavior Report, Grade Report, and STAR Data were discussed.

FFA National Convention is October 27<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>. Fruit sales start October 15<sup>th</sup>.
