Ryan Barnes moved, second by Jason Salas, to approve the following changes to current COVID-19 protocols:

- Any student or staff member who tests positive for COVID-19 will be excluded from the physical school setting for a period of 10 days from onset of symptoms or test date (whichever is earliest as determined by the case investigation) AND must be fever free without medication for 24 hours before returning to the school setting.
- Any student or staff member who, when determined through case investigation, has been identified as being exposed to a COVID-19 individual, will be allowed to attend school and all related activities. These individuals are HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to wear

a mask during the time the health department has recommended them to remain at home.

- Green City R-1 will no longer provide contact tracing information to the Sullivan County Health Department related to COVID-19.
- Green City R-1 will continue to notify families of positive cases and will provide more specific information regarding which grade levels or classes had potential exposure to a COVID positive individual.
