Administrator's Report

Elementary Principal's Report

Jamie Halley presented the Elementary overall attendance rate of 94.85% with enrollment of 136 students. Office referrals were discussed. Accelerated Reader, Math Facts, STAR Reading, and STAR Math data were discussed. There is no school on March 17th and 20th. March 20th will be a professional development day. The Spring Band Concert for 5th through 7th grades and Chorus will be at 7:00pm April 4th. April 5th will be April birthday celebrations and an Early Out. There is no school April 6th and 7th. School will let out early on April 14th for Prom.

High School Principal's Report

Jamie Tipton presented the High School attendance rate of 95% for the month of March with enrollment of 137 students. Behavior Report, Grade Report, and STAR Data were discussed. FFA CDE competitions are currently under way. The band is getting ready for Conference. The band received the high honor to perform and record with the Truman band. High School Girls Basketball season ended with a record of 12-16, 6-2 in Conference tying for 2nd in Conference, and District Runner-Up. High School Boys Basketball ended the season with a record of 25-5, placed 2nd in Conference 7-1, Novinger Tournament Champions, 2nd in LaPlata Tournament, District Champions and Sectional Champions. The Dance Team performed at State Basketball during half time. Gerry Brooks will present on March 20th for Professional Development.

Superintendent Report

Tennille Banner discussed the possibility of Open Enrollment coming to Missouri. It has passed the House and is currently in the Senate. Area Superintendents will meet with Rusty Black next week to discuss. Mrs. Banner will be sending out information and scheduling an informational meeting for the community regarding the bond issue on the April ballot.
