Administrator's Report

Elementary Principal's Report

Mrs. Heidenwith reported 92.1% attendance for March in the Elementary with 150 students enrolled. The Elementary held their 3rd Quarter Awards Luncheon to celebrate academic achievement. Preschool Screenings have been completed. The Elementary Spring Dance was well attended. Fourth and Fifth Graders attended the Children's Literature Festival at Truman. Donuts with Dudes was a huge success. The Annual Book Blast is in full swing. The participation goal was 40% which has been surpassed with a week left to go.

April 13th-17th are dress up days to gear up for MAP testing. April 14th is 4th Quarter Midterm. April 15th-30th will be Spring Benchmark Testing for STAR. April 21st- 30th will be Elementary MAP Testing. May 5th is the Walking Club field trip. May 6th is 5th Grade Promotion. Third grade will visit the Capitol on May 7th. Mother's Day Tea will be May 8th. Third through Fifth grades will tour the hospital on May 8th. Track and Field Day and Elementary End of Year Awards will be May 11th. The Kindergarten and First Grade trip to the Department of Conservation Northeast Office will be May 13th. The last day of school is May 14th.

Office referrals were discussed. Star Early Literacy/Star Reading Data and Star Math Data were discussed.

High School Principal's Report

Mr. Halley presented overall attendance of 93% and enrollment of 125 students in March. Behavior reports were discussed. Star Data and Grade Reports were discussed.

Mr. Halley presented an update on High School events and activities. FFA has ten CDE/LDE teams. The following qualified for State FFA Convention: Horses and Meats, Advance Public Speaking. Three students will be receiving Proficiency Awards and five students will be receiving State Degrees with one Area STAR. Band has 31 members. There are ten students in Choir. The Jazz Band Concert has 30 students participating. Junior High and Varsity Track has 45 athletes. Varsity Baseball has 12 athletes with a record of 1-8. There are five Junior High Scholar Bowl participants, one student made All-Conference, and five High School Scholar Bowl participants.

The student schedule for next year is in review to make sure all students complete all requirements. Senior Decision Day was a success.
